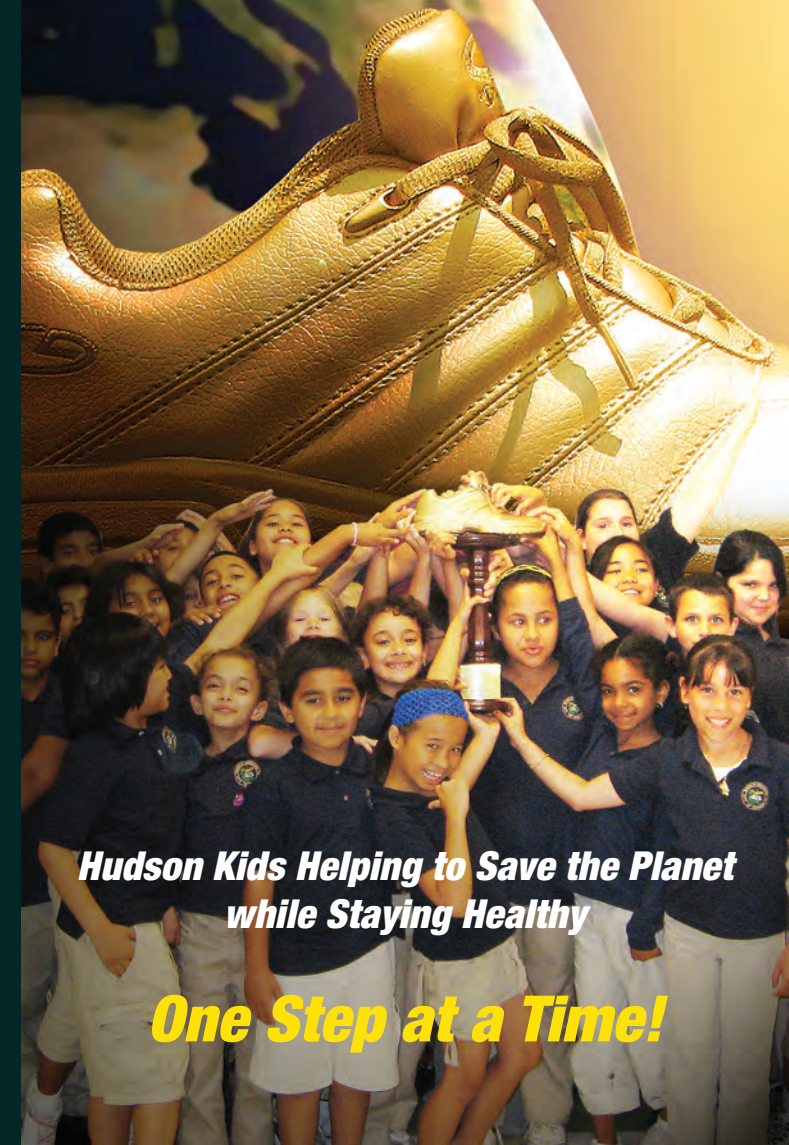

Getting Started

(It's simple...)

The program runs for 1 week (Monday to Friday).

The TMA provides pedometers for students to carry with them to record the number of steps walked during one 24-hour period. **Pedometers are loaned to the school free of charge.**

Teachers assign the students who will record their steps that day. Participants are rotated until every eligible student gets to compete.

Teachers record the data each morning and calculate the number of steps his/her students have walked on the log-sheet provided by the TMA.

The class in your school with the most combined steps WINS!

Increase Learning!

Teachers can, if they wish, turn the program into an additional opportunity for learning by:

MATH

Performing daily tallies and additions
Rank order pedometer readings from lowest to highest

SCIENCE

Discuss the health benefits of walking
Calculate distance
Highlight the benefits to the environment

GEOGRAPHY

Display on a map the possible destinations the class could have reached with their total steps walked
